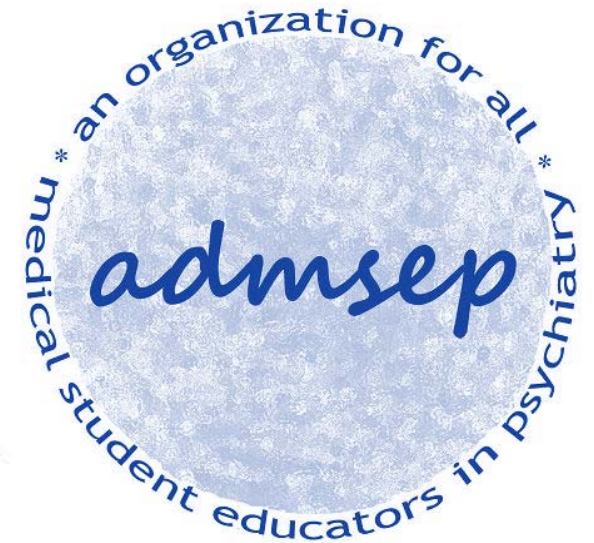


## Why join ADMSEP?

### Background

ADMSEP, formed in 1975, has evolved into a national organization for all faculty dedicated to excellence in medical student education in psychiatry. More than 85% of all medical schools in the US have faculty membership. ADMSEP, the Association of Directors of Medical Student Education in Psychiatry, provides support to faculty responsible for medical student education. Our members network throughout the year via our active list-serve discussions. The annual meeting offers a collegial atmosphere where members update themselves about new requirements, receive mentorship, and give peer reviewed presentations.
